Accessing foreign titles through the library catalogue

The one-card system allows users of the Mitcham Library Service to request community languages materials from other libraries which hold them.

To browse foreign titles:


1. Leave the search bar empty and click "Search" to do a blank search of the catalogue
2. Under the limit tab for Languages on the left of the page select "French" or any other language, then click "Include"
3. Under the limit tab for Shelf Location select "Community Languages" and click "Include"
4. Use the Subject limit options to refine your search to fiction or non-fiction, or browse by available genre
5. Select "Place Hold" on right hand side to request an item and choose any pick-up library from the drop-down list
